In the evening, at the

The Burbank Community YMCA 'Gives a Hand' to Those Lending a Hand

April is Volunteer Appreciation Month

Volunteers are the backbone of any charity. Whether it is sorting food for the Burbank Temporary Aid Center or participating in the April river clean-up for Friends of the Los Angeles River, the extra hands are a critical asset that allows non-profits to continue to provide their services to those in need and make a positive impact in the community.

April is Volunteer Appreciation Month and the Burbank Community YMCA is grateful for their volunteers who support the organization, which promotes Youth Development, Healthy Living and Social Responsibility.

Ranging in age from 11 to 98 – and embracing all levels of ability – 462 Burbank Community YMCA volunteers provided 4,802 service hours last year, helping in a variety of capacities from youth development to sports programming and fundraising efforts.

On average, you will see 10 volunteers at the Y on any given day. The annual Thanksgiving Turkey Trot 5k/10k alone requires 100 volunteers, above-and-beyond Y staff, to stage the popular community event.

As part of her Girl Scout Gold Award application high school senior Ellie Magdaleno, a former Y camper and counselor-in-training, needed to complete a sustainable project for a local community organization. She reached out to the Y's Child Development Center and created a tire crawl for the playground. Made from recycled materials, it's a huge hit with the preschoolers!

Eagle Scout Adam Lueneburg, 17, for his upcoming project, has plans to renovate and paint the Child Development Center fence, a project that will go a long way towards sprucing up the appearance of the Center.

In addition to individuals, the Y is graced with the support of local groups like the Burbank YMCA Service Club and Kiwanis, to name a few. The Service Club, a chartered organization of active men and women who provide leadership for Y volunteer programs, is the group behind the annual YMCA Christmas tree lot. With funds raised at the tree lot, the Y service club has donated a new

van for the Y Child Development Center every year for the past 4 years, completely updating an aging fleet. ... Just one of many things the group does to assist the Y.

Burbank Community YMCA Director of Facilities, Brett Archer, says, "As you can imagine, maintaining the Y building is a huge undertaking in terms of daily upkeep and capital improvements. Without the volunteer support we receive, it would be an impossible task. We are tremendously appreciative of their involvement to make the Y great for the entire community."

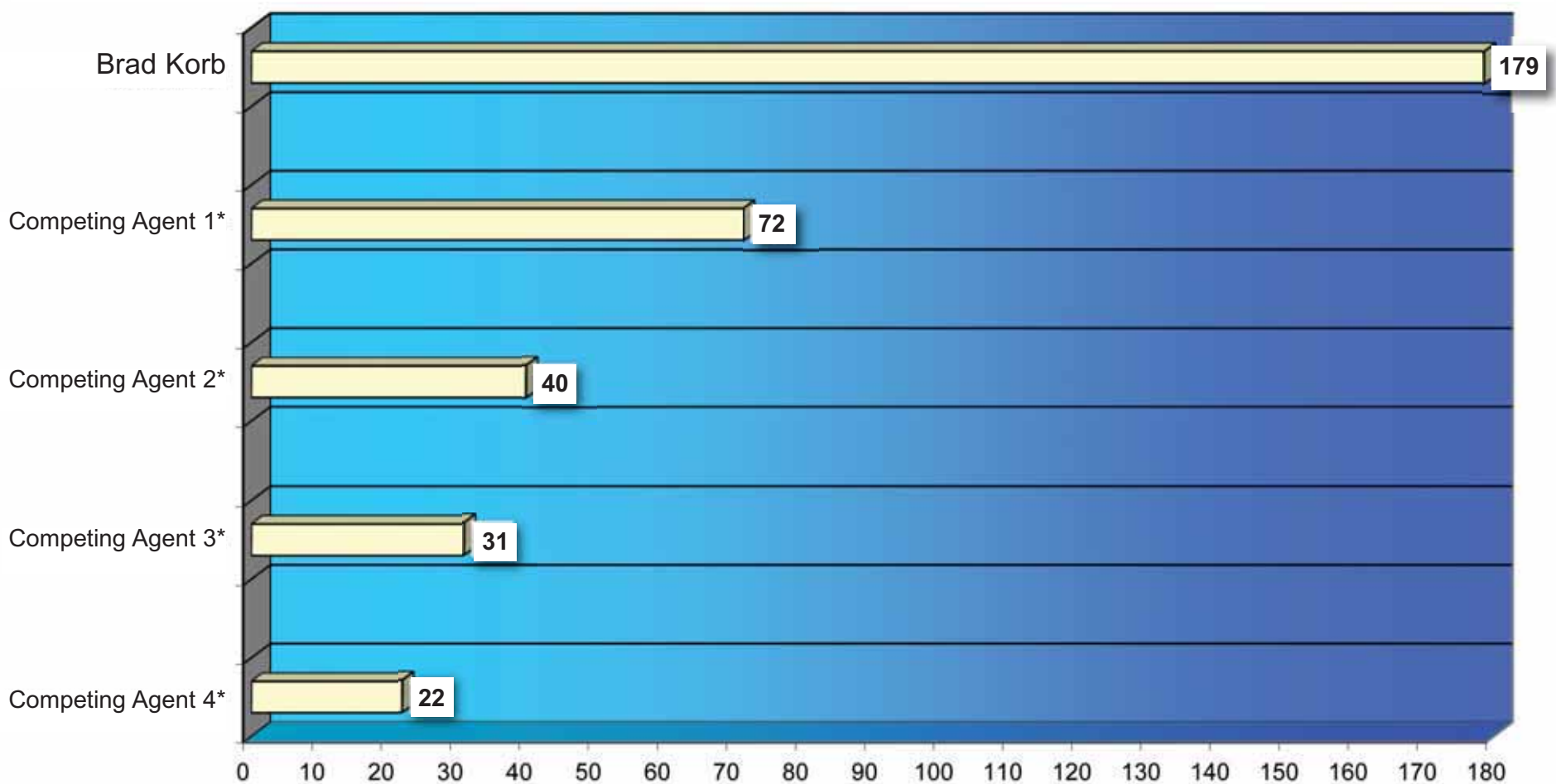

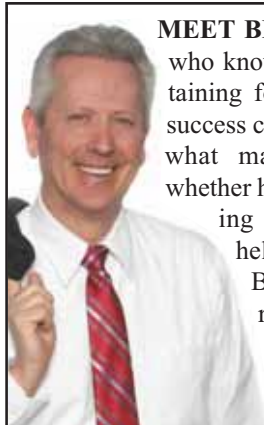

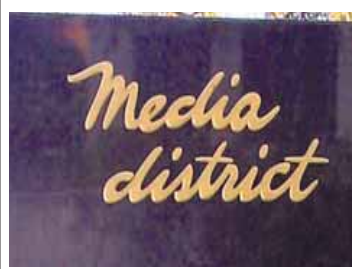
